The undersigned, in order to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, submits the following articles of incorporation to the Secretary of State.

Article 1: The name of the corporation shall be:

Ghana Make A Difference, Inc.

Article 2: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes to aid and assist people and/or organizations in Ghana, Africa, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 3: The street address of the registered office is: 5555 N Star Ridge Way, Star, ID 83669

Article 4: The board of directors shall consist of no fewer than three (3) people. The names and addresses of the initial directors are:

Article 5: The name(s) and address(es) of the incorporator(s):

Article 6: The mailing address of the corporation shall be:

P.O. Box 55, Star, ID 83669

Article 7: The corporation (does does not) have voting members.

Article 8: Upon dissolution the assets shall be distributed:

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article 9: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons. The corporation shall not attempt to influence legislation. The corporation shall not participate in any political campaign.

Article 10: The corporation will not have paid employees, will be operated with volunteer service, and will not pay any compensation to officers and directors for services rendered. The corporation's annual financial statements will be compiled and reviewed by an independent accountant, subject to oversight by a financial committee within the organization.

Article 11: Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code
